5 LENGTHS & 7 TRAINS

Do you know the Vocabulary?

Do you know what an Intermission Length gown is or how far a Watteau Train extends? There are at least five different length styles and seven types of trains available for wedding gowns! Here is a run down of Length and Train vocabulary that you may want to know.

5 LENGTHS

Street

Street Length gowns have a hem that just covers the knees.



This Gown is available in sizes 0-34.

Iridescent Taffeta dress with a pleated strapless bodice. Fitted waist with beaded detail. Full skirt. Optional spaghetti straps included. Also available floor length!

Intermission

Intermission Length gowns have a hem that drops halfway between the knees and ankles. This is also known as Tea-Length.



This Gown is available in sizes 0-30.

Chiffon gown with a draped strapless bodice. Soft trumpet tea length skirt has added back godet for additional fullness. Optional spaghetti straps and stole included. Also available floor length.

Ballet

Ballet Length gowns end near the ankles.



Available in Sizes 0-34.

Tulle gown with a shirred strapless bodice and separate crystal satin sash. Full skirt. Optional spaghetti straps included. Also available in Floor Length.

Floor

Floor Length gowns are the most common for traditional wedding gowns. This length just touches the floor all the way around.



Embellished embroidery overlays the classic, sweetheart strapless bodice. The dropped waistline meets the multi layered tulle skirt with embroidery edging the hemline and chapel train. Removable hemline.

Colors Available: White/Silver, Pearl/Silver

Hi-Low

Hi-Low Length gowns are a combination of intermission length in the front of the gown and floor length in the back. Sometimes the back "low" length can be even longer than floor length.



Crystal Satin dress. This versatile short, sheath dress has a pleated sweetheart neckline. The flared overskirt has a beaded waistband and is completely removable! Removable spaghetti straps and a stole are included.

This style is available short, floor and extra length!

7 TRAINS

Sweep Train

Sweep Trains barely sweep the floor behind the gown.



Luxe Taffeta and Alencon lace overlays the strapless dress with a shirred midriff and skirt with a sweep train. Removable ball gown skirt.

Colors Available: White and Ivory



Court Train

Court Trains extend one foot beyond the sweep train.



Alencon Lace on Delicate Chiffon

Colors Available: White/Silver and Ivory/Silver

Chapel Train

Chapel Trains extend three to four feet. This is the most common type of train length for wedding gowns.



Solid or Two Tone Duchess Satin

Satin Bands frame the sweetheart, strapless neckline and hemline on the princess line gown. Bands frame the corset tie back closure and widen into long, embroidered streamers overlaying the chapel train. Matching shawl included. Available in over 37 colors!

Semi-Cathedral

Semi-Cathedral Trains extend four to six feet.

Delicate Chiffon with Lace

Colors Available: White, Ivory

Cathedral (Monarch Train)

Cathedral Trains extend behind the gown between six and eight feet. This is used at the most formal of American weddings.



Solid or Two Tone Duchess Satin

Satin Bands frame the sweetheart, strapless neckline and hemline on the princess line gown. Bands frame the corset tie back closure and widen into long, embroidered streamers overlaying the chapel train. Matching shawl included. Available in over 37 colors!

Watteau Train (wa-toe)

Watteau Trains begin at the shoulders and falls to the hemline of the gown.



Available in sizes 0-34.

Iridescent Taffeta princess line gown. Strapless bodice with shirring detail. Draped sash loops at back into soft drape. Optional spaghetti straps and stole included. Also available tea length.

Royal Cathedral

Royal Cathedral Trains extend ten feet or more. These are not common except for Royalty. Princess Diana's Royal Cathedral Train is perhaps the most well known Wedding Gown with this type of train in current history.
